Students from Clairfield School joined volunteers from the Coal Creek Watershed Foundation, TN Department of Environment & Conservation, Office of Surface Mining, and TN Mining Association at the reclaimed mine site prepared by Kopper Glo mining. Several hundred hardwood trees were planted including the great American Chestnut tree (pure and hybrids).
